Board of Directors Report, October 1, 2010

- Activities
 - NBH held the first family BBQ on October 1st, which featured delicious BBQ, our first Book Fair and Karaoke and Bounce Houses. It was a great event for our school community!
 - Our magazine fundraiser was profitable for our grade level field trip accounts – we raised just under \$10,000!
- Enrollment
 - Current enrollment is 664 students, which is an increase of 2 students compared to our September report. Our target is 668 and we hope to continue to enroll to get to that level of enrollment.
- Students
 - Our 9th grade has just organized Student Government and held officer elections. This group is planning high school activities and events such as dances, homecoming and fundraisers. Ms. Kira Jordan is sponsoring the Student Government Association for us.
 - Two FCA groups are established at NBH, one for high school and one for middle school. There is excellent student leadership for these groups and are supported by Mr. Steve Beck, Mrs. Debbie Funkhouser and Mrs. Jill Chester.
 - We have nearly completed FAIR testing at our school – there will be one last push to get the remainder of the students tested this week and we will be finished.
- Athletics
 - FHSAA Application for Membership was approved! This is great news for our high school students – our teams are now eligible to play against other schools. We have a JV Girls Volleyball team that will begin play this week and are going to hold tryouts for the JV Boys & Girls Basketball and JV Boys Soccer in October. We did not have enough student interest to field a team for Girls Soccer.
 - Middle School football hosted the first home game on our field last week. It is great to have our own field to host events and is a financial boost to the athletic program!
 - The athletic booster organization is in the initial stages of getting organized. They will have a Board established this month and will begin the process for incorporation soon after.
